There is a carpark in front of the hall and plenty of parking on adjacent roads. Please do not park on the grass of the village green.

Rally Description:

- A tour of around 60 miles to visit signposts identified by only by a photograph, with conspicuous items to spot at each location, a quiz, and a (highly subjective) concours of sorts.
- Bonus points can be claimed by event novices and entrants on older and smaller machines.
- All bikes are welcome, finishers will receive a commemorative badge, but only those over 25 years old are eligible for awards.

We are especially keen to welcome low powered machines including autocycles, cyclemotors, mopeds, scooters and lesser powered veterans and will once again offer the Gutless Wonder Award for these competitors.

- All results will count towards the Western Region Championship.
- Riders are required to visit up to a maximum of 10 of the available signposts. If more than 10 signposts are returned only the first 10, in number order, will count to your final score.
- Photographs of the signposts will be sent out to all participants approximately 2-weeks before the rally. Information regarding the points awarded for each signpost will be provided at the start of the rally. The number of points available for each signpost is based on the distance from the start/finish and the difficulty of the associated question(s).
- All participants and machines must comply with all requirements detailed on the Entry Form below.
- There is no lunch break scheduled, but there should be plenty of time for a break and there are many pubs, cafes, and picnic spots en-route.
- Light refreshments will be available at the start/finish.

Entry Requirements:

- Entry to the Signpost Rally is £12 per participant (riders & passengers).
- VMCC eligible machines must have been manufactured before the end of 2001 BUT entrants on younger bikes will be allowed at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

The Route:

- Signposts will be identified by photographs of the signs and that will clearly show the distance to local towns and points of interest.
- Work out the position of each signpost on the map (O.S. sheet 163) then ride a route of your choice to visit the signposts and find the items requested at each one.

Awards: (at the organisers' discretion)

- The Bovenizer Award – the overall winner – highest points score.
- The Cotswold Signpost Award – the best opposite performance (all will be explained on the day!).
- Best Brace – Pair of awards.
- The Gutless Wonder Award – the best low-powered machine.
- The 'famous' Signpost Concours – the organiser's favourite bike.
- Other meritorious or entertaining performances may be recognised.

All participants completing the Signpost Rally by 15:40 will receive a commemorative badge.
